The main aim is to establish long time cooperation on harmonizing the role, the responsibility and the activity of the provincial museums and to offer chance for practical experience to future professionals in V4 countries. Five Partners from the four Visegrad countries aim at sharing their best practices, their experience on different fields of museum activities in order to improve their social image and to develop into competitive European museums of XXI st century.

Primary aim is to develop the partner provincial museums with limited possibilities and means to become competitive European museums by long-term cooperation and multi-annual joint planning. Organization of a workshop in Kiskunhalas, present the latest research and activities of Partners in Czech Republic, Slovakia, Poland and Hungary. The main purpose is to know each other, to improve professional knowledge and to compare and evaluate the role, the responsibility and achievements of provincial museums in order to reveal the ways how to develop them into a competitive museum on a European level. For the exact comparison we work out a questionnaire and guide that will be used by all Partners in their report. Themes Latest research performed by provincial museums in the V4 region: evaluation of chances and limits Cultural Heritage protection in practice: success and failures Cultural tourism: a chance for sustainable development Public and adult education in museum: present and future A meeting for chief representatives of the Partners at Kiskunhalas to settle the basic principles and scientific themes of a closer cooperation among the Partners. We sign an agreement of intent on the continuation and enhancement of the cooperation and how to develop it into a larger network by inviting partners from Western Balkans and countries of the Eastern Partnership. The participants also discuss how to seek funds possibilities for long time joint projects. Excavation training, one week camp with lectures in the vicinity of Kiskunhalas for students of Partner universities. Tutoria museum lesson how to teach elementary school pupils cultural heritage Excursion visiting several nearby stations of the cultural route developed in an international project implemented by main Applicant.

Our project is characterized completely by “Visegrad feature”. The partners represent all V4 countries. They participate both in the preparation and also the implementation of the activities in a balanced way. The project activities involve the evaluation of the provincial museums of V4 region, joint effort on how to close up to the higher western European level by establishing long-term professional cooperation that we are also planning to widen with inviting partners from Western Balkans and countries of the Eastern Partnership. The common added value created by the project is an agreement signed by all partners that contains the agreement on themes, schedule, tasks and responsibilities of the continuation. In addition the workshop is open to other museum professionals.
